WARNING: TENDER SCAMMERS PRETENDING TO BE CITY POWER OFFICIALS

22 October 2021

City Power warns businesses and residents of Johannesburg about criminals who solicit money from our business partners and suppliers using the names of our officials.

These thieves who claim to be City Power employees ask for money from unsuspecting businesses in exchange for contracts and tenders.

Amongst the names of our officials the criminals have abused for these nefarious purposes include Aubrey Kunene, Charles Mohlaka, Lucky Munyai and Thabang Mashishi, among others.

We can confirm that the above officials do not have the authority nor the ability to give tenders in exchange for money, and further state that not a single one of our employees has the authority to do so.

Our contracts and tenders are not for sale and as such cannot be bought, and as an entity we trust our processes.

We therefore warn our customers, business partners and companies that have submitted applications for tenders and, or contract opportunities not to offer money in exchange for tenders and contracts.

People who offer to give you contracts or tenders in exchange for money, or offer to sell them to you are criminals who want to rob you of your hard-earned money.

The awarding of tenders and contracts go through a rigorous evaluation and adjudication process conducted by teams of different professionals and as a result not a single person can award a tender or give a contract.

In November the City of Johannesburg will join the world in observing International Anti-Fraud Awareness Week, and as City Power we are part of that campaign.

We urge our business partners, potential suppliers, and customer to report any fraudulent activities or transactions to the police, Group Forensic Investigations Services(GFIS), or call Anti-fraud Hotline 0800 002 587 or City Power's Fraud Hotline on 0800 003 251.
